HISTORY OF  
*St. Louis*

St. Louis is a major city in Missouri along the Mississippi River. Its iconic, 630-ft. Gateway Arch, built in the 1960s, honors the early 19th-century explorations of Lewis and Clark and America's westward expansion in general. The Gateway Arch is obviously the big "must-see" in this region, but the city offers other important sites including the Missouri History Museum, the Cathedral Basilica of Saint Louis, and the Anheuser-Busch Brewery.

As you make your way through the city during our visit, uncover the stories of its past and how much of an impact it has had on American history. Visit iconic locations that will take your breath away and be certain to explore the lesser-known areas of the city to get the full immersion of the region.

**ANHEUSER-BUSCH BREWERY**

The complimentary tour of the brewery puts a face on the world's largest brewer. The tour leads you from the tour center to the Budweiser Clydesdale paddock and stable, lager cellar, Brew House, Lyon's Schoolhouse, and Bevo packaging plant. More extensive tours are offered for additional pricing.

**CATHEDRAL BASILICA OF SAINT LOUIS**

Tour this stunning cathedral, also recognized as the Saint Louis Cathedral and is located in the Central West End of St. Louis, Missouri. It was completed in 1914 and is the mother church of Archdiocese of St. Louis.

**MISSOURI HISTORY MUSEUM**

This museum located in Forest Park showcases Missouri's history. The museum was founded in 1866 and features many fantastic permanent exhibits touching topics such as World War I, Civil Rights, 1904 World's Fair, and St. Louis life.
